- ⇒ CashApp (\$2Olive-convenience fee 2.75%)
- ⇒ Givelify (2.9% plus .30 Convenience Fee)
- ⇒ Bring it to the church through the week and place in the drop box
- ⇒ Bring it to the Faith Center on Sundays immediately after worship (103 Dewey Street)
- ⇒ Mail it to 302 Adkins Street, Albany, Georgia 31705
